

KARTSPORT HAMILTON PRACTICE RULES

Due to the Hamilton Kart Track being under noise restrictions we ask you to read the following Practice Rules and to respect these. Going forward we would like the Council to negotiate on these and for us to be in a position to do so it will take all drivers to adhere the following:

- Practice hours are from 9am – 5pm on allocated days throughout the year. Please refer to Practice Calendar under Race Calendar tab on our website for details.
- The Indemnity Form must be completed by all drivers and a practice fee of \$10 for a member and \$20 for a non member paid before going out on the track.
- For drivers not a member of Kartsport New Zealand you must complete and sign a Kartsport New Zealand Practice Licence form.
- Drivers must wear the appropriate safety gear in accordance with Kartsport New Zealand standards.
- Karts must meet Kartsport New Zealand specifications.
- Only practice in your Racing Class. Cadets are not allowed on the track with any other class. Juniors drivers are not allowed on the track with any Senior Drivers at all times.
- Please be respectful of drivers waiting to practice, please limit your session on the track so everyone gets fair practice time.
- All karts must come off the track and stop either at the Scrutineering Shed or entrance to grid area (if there is one or two practicing). There is to be no driving of karts round pit areas.
- No alcohol consumption.
- Please contact Mike Grimshaw on 021 330 452 prior to arriving at the track to ascertain someone is there or is able to be there to unlock the security gates.
- Club Committee contact details, indemnity forms are located inside the shelter located on the grid.
